

2003 grants report

The Vodafone-US Foundation continues to strengthen its presence in the Greater San Francisco Bay Area, with a special emphasis on programs in the East Bay. The past few years have presented unique financial challenges for many non-profit organizations; it is our hope that our support has made a positive impact in our communities.

2003 was an especially remarkable year for our foundation. We partnered with three leading engineering schools in the United States, launching a five-year \$12 million dollar Fellowship Initiative to advance wireless engineering technology. We strongly believe that projects like this will help create more wireless engineering programs and enhance the advancement of wireless technology.
